



Bathroom Policy

For Toddler/Kinder Children:

- 1) Every Thrive Parent who has a potty-training child or child who still needs any adult assistance using the bathroom, needs to fill out our Thrive Kids Bathroom Policy Release Form
- 2) If I child needs to use the restroom, a female Thrive Staff will escort the child to the bathroom.
- 3) Thrive Staff will stay outside the bathroom, not going in alone with a child, especially with a closed door.
- 4) If child needs assistance in any way (wiping, flushing, washing hands, pulling up pants, etc.) a willing female staff may go in and help. (If the staff is not willing/comfortable, they will find another staff who is able to help child with bathroom procedures.) When assisting a child in the bathroom, the door will be left open at all times.
- 5) Thrive Staff will make sure child washes hands and Thrive Staff will wash hands if they assisted with child in restroom.
- 6) Thrive Staff will escort child back to their class/teacher.
- 7) If child is still in diapers and has had an accident, they will be taken into the Nursery to be properly diapered by a Nursery Staff, or parent will be contacted if indicated on Release Form.
- 8) If child has an accident and is not in diapers, parent will be contacted to further assist child.

For Older Children:

- 1) Child will get permission from Thrive Staff to use the restroom.
- 2) Child may go unattended to the restroom that is located in the secured Kids Space.
- 3) Thrive Staff will make sure child returns from the bathroom within a reasonable time frame.
